2. All the candidates participating in the Open Counselling shall have to fill the registration form on the link given below and shall pay the requisite counseling fee of ₹300 with the registration fee at the same day.

Note: Admission will be based on the JEE-Mains score in case of non-availability of JEE-Main score candidates, CUET (Mathematics and Physics) score will be considered for deciding the merit.

4. All the terms and conditions will remain the same as CSAB-2024 except for relaxation in the 10+2 percentage for each category.

Terms and Conditions for Physical Counselling

- 1. Rules related to reservation are as per the norms of the Government of India.
- 2. If the information submitted by any candidate is found to be incorrect, invalid, false, or fraudulent, the seat allotted (if any) is liable to be canceled. Moreover, such candidates will no longer be considered eligible for admission and will also be liable for legal action. Any kind of refund will not be processed.
- 3. The vacant seat matrix displayed to the candidates is tentative. Some additional vacant seats may be available at a later stage of counseling.

4. Regarding the aggregate marks of 60% (or 55% for OBC, SC, ST and PwD)

- Candidate must have secured at least 60% aggregate marks in the Class XII (or equivalent) Board examination. The aggregate marks for OBC, SC, ST, and PwD candidates should be at least 55%. For B.E./ B.Tech. programs, the marks scored in the following five subjects will be considered for calculating the aggregate marks
 - (i) Physics
 - (ii) Anyone of Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology, Technical Vocation subject
 - (iii) Mathematics
 - (iv) A language (if the candidate has taken more than one language, then the language with the higher marks will be considered)
 - (v) Any subject other than the above four (the subject with the highest marks will be considered).
- For calculation of the total marks for five subjects, if the marks awarded in a subjects NOT out of 100, then the marks will be scaled (up or down) to 100 so that the total aggregate marks are out of 500
