INSTRUCTION FOR WRITTEN TESTS

- Candidates are provisionally allowed to appear for written tests subject to fulfillment of eligibility conditions which will be verified at the time of interview.
- Candidates are advised to reach the examination centre at least 45 minutes before the exam starts to complete the compulsory frisking with metal detector and other formalities well before the time. Entry will be closed 30 minutes prior to the commencement of examination.
- Use only black ball point pen for giving answers on OMR sheet. Candidates will be allowed to carry them only the following items into the examination hall/ room:
 - Admit Card
 - Black ball point pen
 - Original Photo Identity
- Candidates without Admit card or having distorted/ tampered photograph in Photo Identity shall not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- Candidates are not allowed to carry the following items inside the examination centre under any circumstances: All ornaments like Ring, Earrings, Chain/ Necklace, Pendants, Badge and Brooch etc. Any metallic item, camera, Watch, calculator, mobile phone, pager, Bluetooth, calculators, geometry/ plastic pouch, blank or printed papers, written chits etc. Candidates must note that no arrangement will be made at the centre for keeping any articles/ items belonging to the candidates.
- Women can wear Mangal Sutra, Bindi & Sindoor. Baptized Sikh candidates are allowed to wear religious symbols.
- The candidate has to show his/ her Admit Card to the invigilator or officials as and when required.

8. In case of Impersonation criminal action will be initiated against the impersonator as well as the candidate.
9. Candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall only after handing over his/ her OMR sheet along with the question paper to the invigilator after the conclusion of test.
10. Candidates must read the instructions given on Question Booklet/ OMR/ Answer Booklet before giving answers.
11. If a Candidate is found using any kind of unfair means his/ her result will be cancelled and her/ she may also be disqualified in addition to other legal action initiating against him/ her.
12. No TA/DA will be paid for appearing the Written Test.
13. Answer scripts of Paper-II will be evaluated only of those candidates who qualify the Paper-I.
