1-1.2	Medical Scheme for staff members:

	recommended that a couple of doctors each at Narnaul and Gurgaon may be empanelled and the staff members can consult these for minor diseases. It was also recommended that in case of emergency, treatment may be taken from any nearest doctor/nursing home/hospital.
1-1.3	Allowance for Wardens of Hostel:  The matter was discussed in detail as being a new University, only a hostel for women was available and the staff members so appointed to look after the hostel shall have to forego HRA. There are allowances being given in other Central Universities to Wardens and others looking after hostels. After deliberations, it was decided to approve an allowance not more than 10% of the Pay and Grade pay of the concerned staff member.
